soft and flavourful with delicate bubbles, with loads of lush summer strawberry and raspberry flavours

golden and bright with apple, pear and citrus aromas *Alcohol-free*

Baron de Villeboerg Brut, Champagne, France 9.80 / 49.00

pale golden yellow colour with fine, persistent bubbles, it has an elegant nose with notes of blossom and yellow apple, with a fresh palate of pear, apple and citrus

Taittinger Brut Réserve NV, Champagne, France (ve) 12.80 / 75.00

the intensely fragrant character, subtle biscuity complexity and superb elegance

Taittinger Prestige Brut Rosé, Champagne, France (ve) 79.00

stylish and dry with delicious summer fruit aromas and a long, full-bodied flavour typical of Pinot Noir based Champagnes

Dom Pérignon Brut, Champagne, France (ve) 185.00

long and satisfying on the palate with layers of yeasty, nutty flavours, superbly fat and ripe; complex, luxury Grand Cru Champagne made only in the best years

Delicate & Light

Verdejo, Ayrum, La Mancha, Spain 6.40 / 8.50 / 25.00

intense aromas of citrus and exotic fruits – fresh, fruity and lively palate

Verdejo (Organic), Castillo de Mureva, Castilla, Spain (v) 7.70 / 10.50 / 30.00

a rich smooth body with balanced acidity and hints of fennel, herbs, citrus fruits, melon and peach

Pinot Grigio IGT (Organic), Vinuva, Terre Siciliane, Italy (ve) 8.10 / 10.60 / 31.00

this Sicilian Pinot Grigio is light, delicately flavoured and refreshingly dry with hints of ripe apple

Vinho Verde, Esporão, Bico Amarelo, Minho, Portugal (ve) 8.30 / 11.10 / 33.00

exuberant citrus and tropical aromas with a creamy texture that leaves a long lingering and refreshing finish

Picpoul, Gerard Bertrand Heritage, Occitanie, France (ve) 8.50 / 11.40 / 34.00

pale yellow colour with hints of green, deliciously fresh on the palate with beautiful notes of lemon and an invigorating finish

Gavi di Gavi, Toledana, Domini Villa Lanata, Piemonte, Italy (ve) 38.00

an unoaked, fresh and minerally white wine, moderate acidity with light, crisp flavours

Chablis Icauna, Burgundy, France (ve) 45.00

fresh, lively with a citrus and white blossom character backed by a finish tinged with minerality

Juicy & Ripe

Chardonnay, Mount Rozier, Stellenbosch, South Africa (ve) 8.30 / 11.10 / 33.00

riper-style chardonnay with apricots, yellow apples and white peach – a touch of oak gives some vanilla undertones, with a fresh crisp finish

Marsanne-Viognier, Élevé, Pays d'Oc, France (ve) 8.00 / 10.70 / 32.00

soft and aromatic with notes of peach blossom and citrus on the deliciously refreshing finish

Monte Velho Branco, Esporão, Alentejo, Portugal (ve) 8.30 / 11.10 / 33.00

citrus notes of lemon and white stone fruit, in a complex and enveloping set

Recommended: Riesling, Ste Michelle Columbia Valley, Washington State, USA (ve) 39.00

crisp apple and white peach flavours with subtle mineral notes, incredibly refreshing and flavourful

Herbaceous & Aromatic

Sauvignon Blanc, Santa Rita 8KM, Central Valley, Chile (ve) 8.30 / 11.10 / 33.00

cold fermented in stainless steel and then bottled early to capture those classic grassy and gooseberry aromas and flavours

Sauvignon Blanc, Petal & Stem, Marlborough New Zealand (ve) 9.20 / 12.20 / 36.00

intense aromas of lime, passion fruit, blackcurrant leaf and fresh herbs, with a distinctive mineral finish

Albariño, Yealands Estate Single Vineyard, New Zealand (ve) 37.00

layers of ripe yellow plum, lifted lime blossom and sea spray. The palate is lively with bright acidity and lingering minerality

Sancerre, Les Collinettes, Joseph Mellot, Loire, France (ve) 49.00

stylish and crisp aromas of gooseberries and powerful fruit flavours, with a clean finish

Full-flavoured & Oaked

Chenin Blanc, Kleine Zalze, Stellenbosch, South Africa 8.70 / 11.80 / 35.00

ripe and silky-smooth with rich guava fruit and honeyed character

Rioja Blanco, Barrel Fermented, Viña Real, Rioja, Spain (ve) 37.00

beautifully balanced and quite delicious with pure, floral and citrus aromas leading into a rounded, creamy, rich palate

Chardonnay, Ste Michelle Columbia Valley, Washington State, USA (ve) 47.00

a fresh, soft style with bright apple and sweet citrus fruit character with subtle spice and oak nuances

green apples, peaches and citrus, bright and refreshing finish – very sophisticated flavours 0.5% ABV

a fine and elegant sweet white wine that goes nicely at the aperitif and also with poultry and white meat or cheese, such as Roquefort



Red

Simple & Delicate

Tempranillo, Ayrum, La Mancha, Spain 6.40 / 8.50 / 25.00
a light and soft, easy drinking red wine with gentle strawberry and cherry flavours

Grenache-Merlot, Crusan, Pays d'Oc, France (ve) 7.70 / 10.50 / 30.00
a lovely soft round wine with fresh fruity blackberry and hints of pepper

Pinot Noir, Mount Rozier, Coastal Region, South Africa (ve) 8.30 / 11.10 / 33.00
a purple tint on the rim with delicious flavours of ripe strawberry and rich red cherry

Beaujolais-Villages Pascal Clément, Burgundy, France (ve) 36.00
aromas of red berries and a refreshingly light, soft palate with fresh, red fruit on the finish

Spicy & Peppery

Shiraz, Berri Estates, South Eastern Australia 8.10 / 10.60 / 31.00
medium-bodied with raspberry, cherry and plum, complemented by vanilla spices

Malbec, Alamos Mountain, Mendoza, Argentina (v) 8.30 / 11.10 / 33.00
aromas of ripe dark berry fruit with notes of sweet spice and a touch of leather - a long and persistent finish with soft, sweet tannins

Rioja Crianza, Viña Real, Rioja, Spain (ve) 9.20 / 12.50 / 37.00
rich aromas of fruit cake and spice with a rounded silky texture and smooth tannins

Primitivo del Manduria, Gocce, Feudi Salentini, Puglia, Italy 48.00
wild berries and caramel with a smooth, rich ripe fruit finish and spicy aromatic notes

Cabernet Sauvignon, Journey's End, Stellenbosch, South Africa (ve) 47.00
rich blackcurrants and black plum with a savoury overlay and mixed spice - a generous oak maturation brings a velvety character with finely textured tannins and a long-lasting finish

Medium-Bodied & Smooth

Tempranillo-Shiraz, Casa Albali, Valdepeñas, Spain 7.70 / 10.50 / 30.00
plenty of ripe cherry and plum fruit flavours, smooth finish

Merlot, Santa Rita 8KM, Central Valley, Chile (ve) 8.30 / 11.10 / 33.00
the perfect balance of concentrated fruit, tannin and acidity - plums and blackberries dominate this wine, with subtle spicy and vanilla notes

Monte Velho Tinto, Esporão, Alentejo, Portugal (ve) 8.30 / 11.10 / 33.00
black fruit and wild berries with intense rich finish

Pinot Noir Reserve, Vidal, Marlborough, New Zealand 42.00
raspberry sweetness showing through a youthful character, yet more structure and complexity developing from barrique ageing

Oaked & Concentrated

Fiorebella Rosso Appassimento, Veneto, Italy (ve) 8.30 / 11.10 / 33.00
a cherry, dried fruit, chocolate and prune bouquet; full-bodied, soft and round, with a spiciness and lingering finish

Shiraz Mourvèdre, Journey's End, Stellenbosch, South Africa (ve) 9.20 / 11.65 / 36.00
a medium-bodied, generous and fruity wine with flavours of forest fruits, cassis and blackberries, with subtle hints of green bell pepper and eucalyptus on the long finish

Saint-Émilion Grand Cru, Château des Bardes, Bordeaux, France 58.00
rich, fruit aromas; juicy, sweet tannins backed by soft touches of vanilla toastiness

Shiraz, St Hallett Blackwell, Barossa Valley, Australia 65.00
an intense long finish with powerful aromas of blackberry, cocoa and nutmeg

Sophisticated & Complex

Malbec, Zuccardi Serie A, Uco Valley, Argentina (ve) 45.00
ripe red fruit aromas of prunes and cherries with black pepper and tobacco; chocolate and spice on the soft and velvety palate

Recommended: Syrah, Ste Michelle, Washington State, USA (v) 50.00
an approachable and fruit-forward style, bright and juicy with ripe berry and hints of vanilla

Côte de Beaune-Villages, Réserve des Jacobins, Louis Jadot, Burgundy, France (ve) 60.00
cherry blossom aromas mingle with gentle hints of spiced barrique character

Rioja Reserva, Contino, Rioja, Spain (ve) 64.00
ruby-red, very fruity with an intense nose showing strawberry, blueberry, vanilla and a balsamic finish; the palate is round, velvety and mouth-filling

Barolo, Enrico Serafino, Piemonte, Italy (ve) 69.00
big, well-structured red, intensely elegant nose with spicy notes of liquorice and vanilla

Low Alcohol

Syrah, Torres Natureo, Catalunya, Spain 6.50 / 8.80 / 28.00
shows lovely, lively hedgerow fruit on a well balanced and juicy palate 0.5% ABV

Rosé

Recommended: Côtes de Provence, Minuty M, Provence, France 10.20 / 13.80 / 40.00
crisp, vibrant bouquet, light and intense flavour, delicious aromas of orange peel and currant, supple to taste, with a nice sharp freshness

Pinot Grigio Rosato, Antonio Rubini, Venezie, Italy (ve) 8.10 / 10.60 / 31.00
a delicate pink wine full of fresh, summer-fruit aromas and flavours

White Zinfandel, Riptide, California, USA 8.00 / 10.70 / 32.00
strawberry and sweet red fruit flavours balanced by a zesty clean finish



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
